The seminar started with a talk on Software development and testing by Mr. Shrikant Rasane.

Mr. Shrikant Rasane is an engineering graduate in Electronics and Telecommunications from Pune University and M Tech Computer Science from IIT, Bombay, India. He has rich experience of over 18 years in software development, training and corporate management. As the co-founder of SEED Infotech he has provided strategic guidance to SEED Infotech to become a leader in IT training industry. During his work as a researcher in ARDE, Ministry of Defence, Government of India, he worked on projects like Test Bench for Fire Control Computer, FCC Launcher Communication unit design and assembly for Multi Barrel Rocket Launcher system. Mr. Rasane in his talk discussed about the opportunities in Software Development in technologies like Java, .Net, databases and object technology. He talked about the burgeoning requirement of skilled IT professionals with good academic record and a consistent urge to grow fast with smart and hard work.

Mr. Rasane spoke about the 4 keys to professional success – Knowledge, Skills, Attitude and the right network. He advised the students to be focused, committed and dedicated to their goal and ambition.

The talk by Mr. Rasane was followed by a talk on the career options in embedded technology area by Dr. Sunu Engineer, CTO, Embedded Computing Machines Pvt. Ltd., Dr. Engineer is a senior scientist with the instrumentation lab at the Inter-University Center for Astronomy and Astrophysics (IUCAA). During his tenure at IUCAA spanning over 10 years, he has been involved with a wide variety of projects involving all facets of Electronic and Software system design. Dr Engineer's inventive and enterprising vision has led the exponential growth of the company in the last two years. He is an avid teacher and instructs students in graduate and post graduate courses at various universities around the world. He holds a PhD in Astrophysics from the University of Pune.



Dr. Engineer gave a deep understanding of the embedded technology industry, its novel facets and the never before opportunities that the field offers for individuals with electronics background with an aspiration to make it big in the IT industry.

The talks were followed by a Question – Answer session. The panel of experts to answer the students' queries comprised of – Mr. Narendra Barhate, MD & CEO, SEED Infotech, Mr. Shrikant Rasane, Director, SEED Infotech, Dr. Sunu Engineer, CTO, Embedded Computing Machines, Mr. Sudip Shah, Senior Embedded Technology Specialist.

The panel answered queries ranging from the IT opportunities for Commerce graduates, mechanical engineering graduates to the right choice amongst .Net and Java as the specialization.

The session received over 350 candidates who had registered in advance for the seminar and around a 100 of spot attendees at the Seminar, organized at the Shailesh Hall, Near Alankar Police Chowkey, Karvenagar.
